Sonic Youth Etc: Sensational Fix

Indie rock band Sonic Youth has always had deep ties to the art world. The band's album covers have been designed by artists such as Richard Prince and Raymond Pettibon; lead singer Thurston Moore used to practice at Vito Acconci's Brooklyn studio, and bassist Kim Gordon is an artist and curator. But instead of just presenting band memorabilia, this exhibition reveals how close-knit the underground music and art scenes in New York were in the 1980s.

Works on show include paint-

ings and drawings used for album covers, photographs of the band, and pieces by artists who have worked closely with the band, including Dan Graham, Tony Oursler, Cindy Sherman, John Miller, Jutta Koether, Isa Genzken, Tony Conrad, Maya Miller and Rita Ackermann. A specially designed pavilion by Dan Graham also plays Sonic Youth's complete recordings, as well as live tapes and videos of other underground bands from the late 1970 and early 1980s, recorded by Graham. Switzerland

Shared Passions: from Cézanne to Rothko, 20th-century Masterpieces in Private Swiss Collections

Celebrating the 25th anniversary of Lausanne's Fondation de l'Hermitage, this blockbuster show is a homage to the foundation's first exhibition, "Impressionism in the Collections of French-speaking Switzerland" in 1984. Since then the foundation has shown thousands of works by Swiss collectors, and this is the institution's tribute to that special relationship. Nineteenth-century highlights of "Shared Passions" include Cézanne's *The Valley of the Arc*, 1878-83, Degas' *Dancers (Dancers at Rest)*, around 1898, and Renoir's *Mother and Child (Gabrielle and Jean)*, 1895. Twentieth-cen-



tury greats include Pablo Picasso's *Bust of Woman in Hat (Dora)*, 1939, Rothko's *No. 15*, 1952, Francis Bacon's *Figure in Movement*, 1976, Gerhard Richter's *Eduard (542-1)*, 1983, and Yves Klein's *Anthropométrie*, around 1960. There are nearly 100 works in the exhibition, and it's a pleasure to see such a mixed array of artists bound only by their collectors. Above, Ferdinand Hodler, *Le Grammont*, 1905. R.S.
